Taos is a place you have to experience to believe! With at base at 9,200 feet, Taos Ski Valley is the largest of New Mexico's eight alpine ski areas, with over 1,200 acres of skiable land. The mountain has terrain for all levels, with about one quarter being easy, a quarter intermediate, and about half advanced, with stunning views of the area. And being north-faced and shaded, the snow conditions are preserved excellently.

The club will be staying on the mountain, not in the town of Taos, at the Snakedance Condos, a favorite of many ski clubs including ours, in 2-bed/2-bath condos.

### **Trip Includes:**

- Round trip airfare from St. Louis to Albuquerque, with transfers to and from the resort and a grocery stop on the way
- 7 nights lodging at the Snakedance Condos (Ski-in/ski out) with a ski storage area/lockers
- Restaurant on Site
- Welcome Party on Arrival, Club Party, and a dinner hosted for the club by Roger, the owner
- Snakedance vest for each skier
- Scheduled trips into the town of Taos

There are many things to do, like enjoy the Bavarian Restaurant at Kachina Basin (*ski down for lunch!*), many great eating places in town, snowshoeing, cross-country skiing, snowmobiling ice skating, and the like. In addition, a trip can be arranged to the Taos Pueblo to see the deer or buffalo dances (*depending on the year*) on January 6, or potentially a ski day at Angel Fire if people are interested. Plus, it's easy to arrange transportation to Santa Fe for a day of museums, shopping, and dining!

Taos accepts the Ikon base pass, but discount lift tickets are available through our travel agent with adults being \$99 per day, seniors (65-79) \$88 per day, and 80+ ski free!

A favorite of many, Steamboat is known for its "Champagne Powder" and unparalleled skiing. We're trying something a little different this year, in line with what many of the other FSA clubs do, and making it a shorter trip of five nights, with four days of skiing. It's also a lodging as we often have people ask if they can do "land only" with the club. (*Note: If you don't want to drive, and aren't comfortable booking your own air and shuttle, the club will do this for you for a small administrative fee to cover costs/time spent.*)

The club will be staying at the Holiday Inn Steamboat Springs this year.

The club last went to Jackson Hole in 2017. It was a fantastic trip and they had total snowfall of 593 inches that season. We are excited to be headed there again in 2026! There are many things to do in the area: skiing, snowshoeing, dog sledding, snowmobiling, the National Elk Refuge, Yellowstone National Park, Grand Tetons National Park, shopping, admiring local artist's work in the many galleries, fantastic food and nightlife, and enjoying the town square (a one of a kind, truly unique experience and picture MUST), winter bike tours, and great skiing.

The resort contains over 2500 acres of in-bound terrain and a whopping 4,139-foot vertical drop serviced by 13 lifts including Bridger Gondola and "Big Red", Jackson Hole's world-famous Aerial Tram

Trip Includes:

- Round trip airfare from St. Louis to Jackson Hole on American Airline, with transfers to-and-from the airport.
- 7 nights lodging at the ELK Country Inn (hotel, 2 persons per room, 2 queen beds)

Winter Park is a favorite resort for skiers in the Summit Area! It's the closest major mountain destination to Denver at just 67 miles away, but don't be fooled by the convenient location; you'll feel remotely tucked away in a high country corner of the Rockies. With easy access to 765,000 acres of public land, Winter Park Resort boasts a diverse range of 166 designated trails and 1,212 acres of off-piste terrain, including the challenging Vasquez Cirque and glade skiing areas. The resort is serviced by 23 lifts, including high-speed six-packs, a 10-person gondola, and various quad, triple, and double chairlifts. These lifts provide access to all areas of the mountain, including Winter Park, Mary Jane, Vasquez Ridge, Parsenn Bowl, Eagle Wind, and The Cirque areas.
